# **EVOLSAR** — The First Steps

#### • Italy 2011:

- Signing of a Twinning Protocol between EFRU (Malta) and EDELWEISS (Italy)
- An agreement to commence search for possible partners







# EVOLSAR — Developing the Association

  - EDELWEISS (Italy)
  - EP. O.ME.A. (Greece)

- EPS (Portugal)
- CCPVC (Cyprus)







# **EVOLSAR** — Its Birth

- Italy 10th May 2014
  - The signing of the EVOLSAR STATUTE and the Foundation Agreement by the 5 teams















### **EVOLSAR** — The Statute

- EVOLSAR has been set up with the SCOPE that:
- each group would be able to travel to assist fellow members, from other countries
- EVOLSAR volunteer teams within an affected country may call upon other European teams within EVOLSAR to assist under their own umbrella
- Upon EVOLSAR's arrival in the affected area, the home team will inform the LEMA / OSOCC of its strength and capabilities



# **EVOLSAR** – Membership

- Constituted of Voluntary Rescue Organisations coming from various European countries
- Lead Member Team
- The first organisation to join EVOLSAR from any given European country will act as a Lead Team for any subsequent rescue organisations that are to join EVOLSAR from that same country
- The Lead Team is responsible for managing the administration of any teams coming from its country and it shall be the principal point of liaison among the EVOLSAR Presidency, the EVOLSAR Administration



# **EVOLSAR** — Membership

#### Affiliate Member Team

- Member teams that will join EVOLSAR from countries already represented in EVOLSAR shall join as **Affiliate Teams**. Affiliate teams are represented at the Executive Committee level by the Lead Team of that respective country.
- For any specific country, the affiliation of other teams apart from the lead team will have to be nominated / approved by the country's lead team for consideration at the Association's Executive Committee.



# **EVOLSAR** - Membership

#### ASSOCIATE Member Team

- First major change in statute discussed in late 2015 allowing teams coming from non EU countries to team up in EVOLSAR as Associate Member Teams.
- The Associate Team will have the right to participate in any event and activity including training opportunities with other members of EVOLSAR. Associate Teams will be managed directly by the EVOLSAR EC and the Administrative office depending on the situation vis-à-vis operations in training or deployment.





### A Rescue Operations Manual

#### Working Method:

- Transnational meetings bring together team experts to discuss the framework of each chapter of the manual
- Each team develops the content of the respective rescue discipline
- Peer review of the content by another team to approve it and suggest possible improvements
- Training activities bring together rescue teams to test in practice some elements of the rescue techniques included in the manual
- Feedback from these training activities is used to develop or improve the content of the rescue manual

# A Rescue Operations Manual –

- Further EU funding Specific Programmes
- INSARAG recognition and possible accreditation in some modules
- Continue with steadfast enlargement within the EU sphere and even beyond.
- Other teams already interested (some in an advanced state of evaluation):
  - SARAID UK
  - Bombeiros Voluntários De Peniche Portugal
  - Unidad Canina Rescate y Salvamento Madrid Spain
  - Gruppo Comunale di Protezione Civile di Fermo Italy
  - Rescue GR Greece
  - Serbian Rescue Team Serbia



- Establish a full deployment protocol for a possible Major Team deployment
- Establish a deployment procedure for within Europe and outside the continent
- Establish a deployment strategy:
  - Partial
  - Gradual
  - Full
- Establish a logistics branch that can tackle such deployments



- Establish a good working relationship with EU Civil Protection Mechanisms in Brussels and in each country of member origin.
- See what funds could be made available to support EVOLSAR teams at home
- Investigate training opportunities already available through the Civil Protection Council for individual teams and key persons from the teams
- Investigate the possibility of enacting working protocols with local Civil Protection departments



- Evaluate further Training Needs for the teams and individuals depending on criteria set by the EVOLSAR EC and operational needs
- Establish a system of evaluation and assessment for the teams and their volunteers
- Establish a training mechanism within EVOLSAR to facilitate training and continue with the standardisation of operations
- Establish a system of SOPs to guide each team and volunteer in their training and operations.
- Organise training activities in various countries to improve on the experience and interoperability
